### What is DTN SI?

The Disability Training Network's Summer Institute (SI) is a professional development opportunity offered exclusively to Texas A&M University System faculty, administrators and staff who interact with students with disabilities. The purpose of DTN is to improve access, retention and success for college students with disabilities.

DTN will provide hotel accommodations for the nights of June 24th and 25th. The Holiday Inn & Suites will honor the discounted rates per night for two days before and after the Summer Institute, based on availability. SI participants are encouraged to share hotel accommodations and travel together with others from their university. Travel and meal expenses will be reimbursed at the state rates allowed. Spaces for the Summer Institute are limited.
